Set out below is a summary of the decisions taken at the meeting of Kingston Town Neighbourhood Committee. The wording used does not necessarily reflect the actual wording that will appear in the minutes.

1. Appointment of Chair and Vice Chair 2017/18

Resolved that Councillors Maria Netley and Hugh Scantlebury be appointed as the Chair and Vice Chair respectively.

2. Planning application 16/13215 - 178 King's Road KT2 5HU (the former Richmond Park Tavern)

PERMIT with amended Condition 3 and additional conditions 9 and 10.

3. Planning application 16/13258 - Land to the rear of and including 18 Geneva Road, KT1 2TW

REFUSED

4. Planning application 17/12102 - Development Land rear of 20 Orchard Road

PERMIT

5. Enforcement - 10 Borough Road KT2 6BD

The Committee agreed that an enforcement notice should be issued.

6. Roads East of Richmond Road - results of consultation

Resolved that -

1. Consultation takes place on the removal of CPZ in Albany Park Road; and
2. Two free parking bays be introduced for up to one hour and no return within two hours in St Alban's Road for people attending the GP and dental surgeries; and
3. A report be submitted to a future Committee meeting next year, outlining the parking review to the area.

7. Kings Road - introduction of traffic management measures

This item was withdrawn from the agenda and will be considered at the meeting on 5 September 2017.

8. Park Road review of traffic management system

Resolved that -

1. The consultation results are noted;
2. Subject to no objections being received to the Traffic Management Orders:
 - a) The 20mph zone in Park road between Kingston Hill and Tudor Drive is implemented; and
 - b) The existing temporary single yellow line in Park Road between Bat Gardens and Kelvedon Close is made permanent.

9. Mill Street - objections to double yellow lines

Resolved that -

1. The representations received in response to the publication of the Traffic Management Order (TMO P-248) are noted and the objections set aside; and
2. The position of the double yellow lines will be agreed by the Chair, Vice Chair and Ward Councillors following discussions with the Fire Brigade; residents will be informed, and the Traffic Management Order implemented.

10. SO32 - Enforcement action - 1 Nightingale Mews, South Lane, KT1 2NS

Resolved that the urgent enforcement action under SO32 for 1 Nightingale Mews, South Lane is noted.
