Hello,

I live on foxglove lane which is a dead end road, there is a junction to come in and out of the street which is continuously tight to drive in when cars are parked on both sides of the road. We recently had to call the fire service to our property and they could not get access to the street, luckily it was a false alarm, also many times we have missed bin collections due to them not being able to fit, these should all be logged to see for reference also. Please see picture below for proposal of extending double yellow lines to make access better for residents, emergency services and your bin lorries.

I will also add a vast majority of foxglove lane Residents have a private parking space at the rear of the property's which is rarely used so by extending double yellow lines it will not cause more congestion.
