Thank you for the follow up on this issue. The amended proposal looks like a good compromise to me, so yes I would not have any objection to this.

However I do think it's worth pointing out that traffic and parking are a significant issue here - on Foxglove Lane alone there are 44 houses - if each house has just one car that's 44 cars to park, but many have two cars. And not all residents have their own spaces around the backs of the properties - or perhaps they do but prefer to park at the front. Some kind of labelling system for the parking spaces would be very helpful to know which bays are for general use and which bays are privately owned for particular properties.
